



## Edward Lewis Fennell

February 22, 1931 - April 29, 2018

Edward Lewis Fennell, affectionately known as Lewis, made a peaceful transition into eternal life on April 29, 2018, at the age of eighty-seven. He was born on February 22, 1931, in North Hampton County, North Carolina, the third son of the late Emmitt Fennell and Essie Harding. He worked tirelessly for over 30 years at the Omni Shoreham Hotel, until he retired. Lewis was "good with his hands". He could fix anything! After working as a mechanic at the Shoreham for a number of years, he was promoted to Foreman.

Two of his favorite things were Westerns and animals. He often settled down

in a warm, quiet place and watched shows like Gunsmoke, Bonanza, Wagon Train, Laramie, and anything else with cowboys. It didn't matter if he had seen it a hundred times. Some of the shows were older than his children! He also loved watching National Geographic and Animal Planet.
