Frances Tyler Butler was born July 8, 1933 in Alexandria, VA. She was the oldest of seven children born to the late Emma Tyler. She departed this earthly life on October 2, 2018 at the Mount Vernon Rehabilitation Center, Alexandria, VA.

Frances attended the Alexandria City Public Schools. Upon completion of school, Frances began working at the George Mason Hotel in Alexandria, VA. Frances spent many years of her younger life living and working in New York City. Frances later worked as a licensed beautician, often providing service without pay. For many years she was also a healthcare provider, providing care to elderly residents. These residents and their families became more like a part of her family. Frances had a loving, caring Christian spirit. She gave freely to strangers and those in need, never asking for anything in return.

In 1950, Frances became one of the first members of the Antioch Church of Christ under the first Pastor, J. P. Steadman. Frances was Secretary to Pastor Steadman, as well succeeding pastors, Elder Henry W. Roberts and Elder George Thompson. She worked tirelessly on many ministries. She was the President of the Pastors Aid, Willing Workers and Young Peoples Club. She served as Head of the church's diner, working many, many long tireless days to raise funds to pay off the church mortgage. She was also a member of the Church Choir. Frances loved the Lord and her church. Antioch was a central

part of her life. She was the oldest living member of the Antioch Church of Christ. If you talked to Frances any length of time, her conversation always turned to the Bible and the goodness of the Lord. Frances had a great love for her family and friends.

Frances is preceded in death by: her mother, Emma Tyler; stepson, Rocco Johnson; brother, William Tyler; and sister, Alice Gordon.
