George Melvin (Butch) Scott, Jr., entered into eternal life on October 18, 2015, at the age of seventy. He was born on April 3, 1945, in Alexandria, Virginia, the only son of Mary B. and George Melvin Scott, Sr. Butch enjoyed a delightful childhood, growing up with his two sisters and his cousins (who lived across the street), especially Elwood Scott, Jr. Butch and Elwood looked more like brothers than cousins, and shared a sibling-like relationship, just as their fathers had.
