John Morgan, Jr. was born on October 2, 1931, to the late John P. and Nora Morgan in Nash County North Carolina. He was the 7th of eleven children. On October 17, 2019, God quietly took John home after allowing him to live and made his mark upon the earth for 88 years. He left too soon, but make an indelible print upon all our lives.

John received his education in Spring Hope, North Carolina. He accepted Christ at an early age, at the Red Oak Baptist Church in Stanhope, North Carolina, where he received the foundation for his life-long spiritual growth in Christ. Having worked with his family on farms in Nash and neighboring Warren Counties, he served a tour of duty in the United States Army from 1953 to 1955, and rejoined his family in Wise, North Carolina where he met and married the love of his life, Mamie.

Seeking employment opportunities beyond those provided in farming; in 1955, they relocated to Alexandria, Virginia. He was employed as a mechanic at Fort Belvoir and Fort McNair for many years. Following retirement from the federal government, he was employed by the Alexandria Schools as a bus driver. He loved his job and enjoyed interacting with the kids, especially those with disabilities. Several months after retiring from the school system, he was itching to work again and accepted employment as a driver with the Phillip Bell, Sr. and Winona Morrisette-Johnson Funeral Services, P.A.

Under the pastorate of the Late Reverend Doctor Austin A. Booker, he joined the Ebenezer Baptist Church in Alexandria, Virginia. John was an active and

devoted church member, participating in its various ministries. He was a faithful usher and served as President and Business Manager. He was also a member of the Interdenominational Church Ushers Association of Virginia, Inc. where he served as an Officer and Instructor. After having served more than twenty years as a loyal and dedicated trustee, the church bestowed upon him the honor of Trustee Emeritus. The work of the church was where John found his greatest fulfillment in life. He served as Vice Chairman and Chairman of the Trustee Ministry. In the final analysis, he understood that it is only what you do for Christ that will last.

John was a member of Universal Lodge No. 1, Free and Accepted Masons, Prince Hall, P.H.A. On September 10, 2016, John received his Fifty Years Membership Certificate and Pin. He served as Worshipful Master from 1968 - 1969.
