



Mrs. Justine Newman Carter

December 20, 1926 - June 23, 2022

Justine Carter was born Iris Josteen Newman on December 20, 1926, to Elizabeth Daniels Newman and Linwood John Henry Newman. One of 12 children, Justine began her journey as a loyal and faithful servant of the Lord at the age of 4, showing interest in Catholicism and being permitted by the Oblate Sisters to sit in on classes. When she was 6, she was baptized as a Catholic after promising her father, a Baptist minister, she would be the best Catholic she could be. The life she led, with a desire to serve, was dedicated to the fulfillment of that promise. Her siblings followed her lead and were soon baptized Catholic. This would not be the last time Justine led the way for others to embody what it truly means to be a Christian, as she continued throughout her life to give of herself to the Church and to the community. By the age of 16, she was a regular volunteer at St. Joseph Catholic Church. Justine graduated from Parker-Gray High School in Alexandria, Virginia in 1944. She attended Cortez W. Peter Business School, where she studied to be a secretary and received a diploma in 1945. She wanted to serve as a stenographer or a reporter. However, she met Alfred DuBois Carter, fell in love, and married on January 23, 1953. Their loving union spanned 64 years until his death in 2017.

Throughout her life she selflessly epitomized the spirit of volunteerism through her work at the Alexandria Department of Health's Dental Clinic until her retirement in 1984. As a testimony of her outstanding service, she received the Flora Krause Casey Public Health Award for her dedication to improving

the health of the Alexandria community, specifically addressing the medical needs of the low-income community.

For many decades the name Justine was virtually synonymous with the name Saint Joseph Catholic Church. In fact, you would be hard pressed to find someone who had attended a Catholic Church in Alexandria and did not know the name Justine. In fact, legend has it that Justine visited St. Joseph every day for 84 years attending to her life's work. She was the perfect example of our patron saint as a worker for the Lord. During her many years of service, she participated as a member or leader of virtually every organization and ministry, supporting every Pastor (14) in the church's history. Her legacy of volunteerism was witnessed by her children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren when they accompanied her to mass and her favorite church sponsored events.

Justine loved every feast or holy day, especially Easter and Christmas. Being a staunch Catholic, every major celebration began at Mass and continued at the family home filled with Justine's Magical Brand of Love and Sharing. This magic extended into birthdays and other family celebrations, making sure there was always a special gift to unwrap from Momma or "Granny." In most of these events she was sure to receive a special music box or doll. This always left a big smile on her face.

Justine is survived by her four children; Anthony DuBois Carter, Kim Carter Turner, Krista Carter York (Bill), and Kevin Edwin Carter (Melissa); 7 grandchildren: Langston Turner (Tamara), Nicole Turner, Kourtney Skinner, Dominic Turner, Eugene Skinner III, Kevin Carter, Jr., Aiden Carter and 5 great-grandchildren: Ayanna Rowe, Tyrone Rowe, Jr., Langston Turner, Jr., Madyson Turner, and Jurnee Turner. Justine has many beloved family members and friends. Some are also lifelong members of St. Joseph Church to include Jesurena Griffin, Linwood Smith, Sharon Frasier and Lillian Newman.

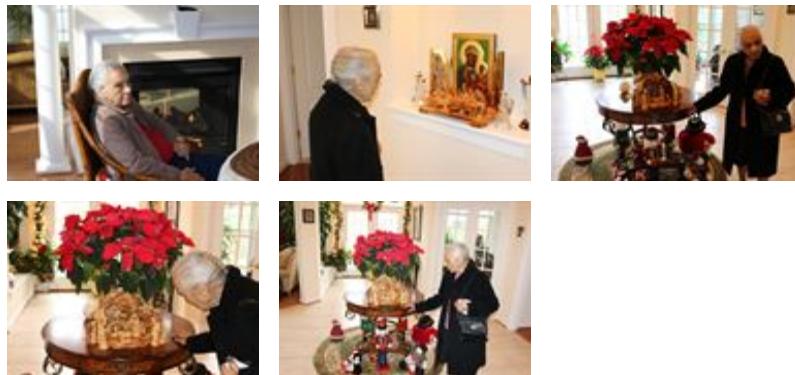
