Kirk was born on July 23, 1934 in Alexandria, Virginia. He spent his early years living with his family in Fairfax County on Riverside Road. He went to elementary school in Gum Springs. He was baptized and joined Bethlehem Baptist Church as a teenager. Later, Kirk attended Parker Gray High School in Alexandria, VA where he played football and was a good student.

Kirk graduated from Parker Gray High School as class salutatorian. He then went on to obtain a bachelor's degree in Psychology from West Virginia State University in 1955. While at West Virginia State he proudly became a member of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity.

After college Kirk returned to Virginia where he married his wife Mary and they had three children: Deborah, Reggie and Michael. Kirk began his career in social service. He worked as a federal employee for over 30 years holding various positions including Youth Services Counselor and Youth Probation Officer in the District of Columbia. Kirk was a hard worker, and one 30-year career was not enough. After retiring from the federal government, he went to work for Fairfax County and worked an additional fifteen years as a bus driver. Known for his sense of humor, it was impossible to spend any amount of time with Kirk and not come away laughing. He always had a joke, a commentary on current events or politics that would keep you laughing.

Kirk loved being with family. He especially enjoyed backyard barbecues, holiday dinners, and watching the children open Christmas presents. Even in his 80's, Bubby was known to spontaneously show up at his big sister's house with ice cream and cake to celebrate a birthday!
