Nathan was multi-talented. A pillar in his community and a philanthropist at heart. For over 14 years, he established back-to-school drives, toy drives, and turkey giveaways and provided meals for the homeless and less fortunate. Nathan also provided houses for men and women to reunite back into society.

Nathan loved the Lord. His favorite gospel group was the Canton Spirituals, and his favorite scripture was Isaiah 54:17 "No weapon formed against me shall prosper." 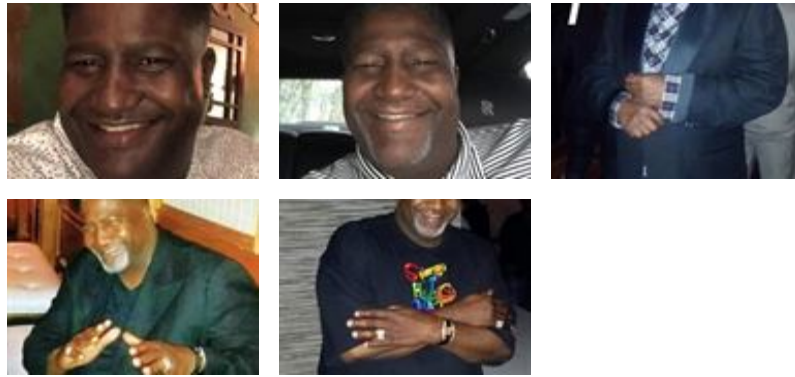
