Deacon Ollie Mae Johnson was born January 18, 1935 to the late Reavie and Ella Mae Everett in Robersonville, North Carolina. She is the second of thirteen children, ten brothers and two sisters. Growing up, she was a mother figure to her siblings, often cooking, cleaning and assisting with them. She even would help her brother with his schoolwork before doing hers. On Thursday, August 13, 2020, Deacon Ollie Johnson departed this life at Mt. Vernon Hospital in Alexandria VA.

Deacon Ollie left the south to move to the north to live in Brooklyn, New York, upon reaching adulthood. She met Deacon Hugh Johnson and later they married. 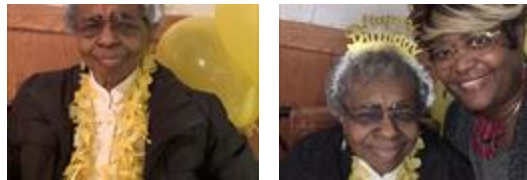
