Tyrone was the youngest of seven children. He received his formal education in the Alexandria Public Schools where he attended George Washington Middle School and Parker Gray High School. In 1994 Tyrone accepted Christ in his life and united with the Assembly of the Saints Church under the leadership of Bishop George Haskins. In 2010 he renewed his love for Christ and united with Resurrection Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor Leonard Massie. He was known for his extravagant suits which were matched from his hat to his gators! Tyrone was a member of a harmonic, Acapella street corner vocal group called "After the Storm" (formerly known as Alexx). The group's founders were Tyrone, Reggie Washington and Tony Harris. Tyrone carried the seductive sweet sound as the second tenor and instructed the choreography. He was known as the jokester of the group and had a talent for getting the audience involved with his great sense of humor. Tyrone leaves to cherish his memory: his

daughter, Theresa Menefee; four grandchildren, Damarius, Isreal, Asia, and Phoenix; five sisters, Bernice (Willie) Simmons, Geneva (Robert) Peace, Eloise (George) Kelly, Linda (Rick) Stewart, and Adrian Cloud; one brother, Albright (Stephanie) Cloud, Jr., plus a host of nieces and nephew other relatives and friends.

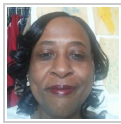
